



In order to achieve the envisaged goals, there is a need of a sound, progressive and dynamic educational policy which will cater to the global demands of the present time. In this scenario, the Government of India has taken a visionary step by approving the new National Education Policy, 2020 on 29th July, 2020. The NEP 2020 is the first education policy of the 21st century which aims to address many growing developmental imperatives of our country and is aligned to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. It is built on the foundational pillars of Access, Equity, Quality, Affordability and Accountability.

The NEP 2020, approved by the government replaces 34-year-old National Policy of Education 1986 (NPE), aims at paving the way for transformational reforms in School Education and in Higher Education as well to make India a global knowledge superpower.

The New Education Policy emphasizes to ensure universal access to high-quality primary education across the country in a phased manner. Special attention and priority are given to districts and locations which are particularly socioeconomically disadvantaged. It also seeks to ensure foundational literacy and numeracy in a mission mode. There is a host of curricular changes and reduced content load in school education, curriculum as well as assessment reforms for holistic development of students.

NEP 2020 promotes active pedagogy, development of core capacities and life skills, including 21st century skills, experimental learning at all stages; transformation in assessment to promote critical and higher order of thinking among students, mainstreaming of vocational education and reforms in teacher education. NEP 2020 focuses on empowerment of teachers, improving their recruitment, service conditions and career progression opportunities at all levels. This policy envisions a complete overhaul and re-energising of higher education system and considers research and innovation to be the two pillars of nation's development.

St. Xavier's College of Education (Autonomous) Patna has been accredited with grade 'A' in 3rd cycle by NAAC. It is one of the leading institutions since 1988 catering to the needs of the society irrespective of any religion, caste, creed or any section of people offering B.Ed., M.Ed., Ph.D. in Education and a few add on courses.
