Father Chandy Passes Away

Father Chandy Moolayil S.J., the Patna Province coordinator for Jesuit Alumni Association passed away on 23rd December, Thursday morning at Kurji Holy Family Hospital after a brief illness. He was buried on Friday at XTTI, Digha.

Born on August 24, 1937, Father Chandy came to Bihar in 1957 and taught at Ara Catholic School for one year before shifting to St. Michael High School, Patna, where he taught English for four years. Later on, he joined St. Xavier's High School in 1984 where besides teaching he looked after the St.

Xavier's Alumni Association as its moderator. He also taught at De Nobili, Digwadih, Dhanbad, for four years before becoming the administrator of XTTI, Digha. Before breathing his last, Father Chandy was the minister at the St. Xavier's College. Father Chandy was associated with St. Xavier's College of Education, Patna, from the time Alumni Association started in 2003.

Members of SXCEAA and large number of teachers paid their last respects to the departed soul. The Principal and Staff of the College paid their respect and prayers for the departed soul. May his soul Rest in Peace.
