Tarumitra Dr. Fr. Robert Athickal S.J, was the resource person to unfold the benevolence of mother earth with his presentation; interjected with clips on the richness of trees and plants. He has clearly spelled out the ecological crisis and exhorted us to be environmental-friendly, an agent to initiate save mother earth movement in our lives by using CFL LED bulb than tube-lights, using water sparingly and planting trees in our home yard. A guest speaker Dr. Prashant from the Central University of Bihar enlightened the participants with the need to incorporate environmental studies as a part of our regular syllabus and how teachers can play a big role by making the students aware. He explained the aim, objectives, goals and the importance of environmental studies in today's life.

Trainees had to present a class in their teaching subject with inclusion of the environment education in the topic. The two days seminar came to an end with the Earth dance. This was to bring the trainees nearer to mother earth. Faculty members were also present for the two days seminar on environment education for sustainability.



Workshop on Human Rights

It was on Saturday, 7 Feb 2015, a workshop on Human Rights was organized at SXCE.

Immediately after the prayer service, the Principal welcomed the panel of experts and observed: "Seminar on Human Rights is one of the annual features of the college. It is very important for us to make

the future teachers aware of human rights. Teacher's role in the society is to inculcate in students the value of human rights".

The panel consisted of Fr. Philip Manthara S.J., member, PUCL, Bihar., Dr. Daisy Narayan, President State Child Rights Board, Bihar and President PUCL, Bihar and (Prof.) Vinay Kanth, member of PUCL, Bihar.

Fr. Philip Manthara S.J. said, "As human beings we have natural rights and as nobody gives us this right, no one has the right to take them away from us. The Preamble to the Constitution is just not there to be in papers but it should become a reality, teachers should bring this change." He further said that UN is celebrating its 70th year of foundation and the Education Commission of 1964-66, spoke about values. Teachers have a great role to play to bring awareness among students. Later trainees were divided in seven different groups for group discussion on the different questions given to them.

Prof. Daisy Narayan, President, State Child Rights Board, Bihar, spoke on child right. She said, "Every child has the right to life, good health, sanitation and education". In her input, she said, "Violence meted out to women is against her fundamental rights; child abuse and deprivation against free and compulsory education and adult responsibility in protection of children must be looked into seriously. She underlined that war is won not on the battlefield, but in our own primary classroom. The teacher should love to teach, love those whom we teach only then we can be good teachers in life. School is an institution where we are teaching constitutions, values, rights and human development and so teachers' role is important. If every child gets his right we can have a changed society where every one will have a place of respect and dignity."

Prof. Vinay Kanth, member PUCL talked on importance of universal education. He called us to make use of constitution to protect our rights. On child's rights, he said, "Education is every child's right; if we deprive anyone from his right it is injustice towards the child. Teacher should be a role model for a child and if the teachers who teach values are not driven by values then they can make no meaning in the lives of children."

Future teachers were called to join PUCL and help to raise the voice supporting human rights and checking the violation.
