ASHA DEEP

St. Xavier's College of Education does not teach its students only to apply themselves and make great careers. Instead it leads them to head out into the community and try things they haven't done before. On 25th Jan, 2019 a special Community Service programme was organised at Asha Deep Rehabilitation Centre. The trainees got an opportunity to empathise with the children, understand the harsh realities of life and thereby intermingle with them, help them and most importantly treat them with respect and dignity.

Every year the trainees visit this centre to have an experience of working with the differently-able children who are mentally or physically challenged. Here these children get access to high quality appropriate services. This was a kind of experiential learning, an approach to connect lessons learned in classrooms with real-life lessons through community service. The trainees with the help of the principal of the centre and their college professors distributed themselves in groups. Then, with different interesting and creative methodologies tried to help the children with their academics teaching them subjects like English, Hindi, Maths, Science etc. They conducted story-telling and singing sessions, imparted entertainment and education through play-way method, thus helping them increase their creative skills. Earlier these trainees had experienced teaching normal children in normal schools, but this was a very different experience of teaching children with special needs. They cherished dealing with these children. They all tried their best to bring smiles and happiness to the children. Finally the trainees presented a report upon their experience at the centre.

EDUCATIONAL EXCURSION

SXCE organised a one day educational excursion for B.Ed. students (2018-2020) on 27th Jan 2019. An educational excursion acts as the groundwork for enriched learning experiences. The principal purpose is to edify students, providing them hands-on-exposure to learn from a new set of proficiencies in a natural setting. Therefore, a field trip to

Pawapuri, Nalanda and Rajgir was organised under the proper guidance and supervision of the college principal, teachers and staff members. Three buses were arranged. First of all we visited "Jal Mandir" at Pawapuri. Then visited "Shanti Stupa" atop a hillock at Rajgir through a rope-way. Lastly, we visited the most primitive and renowned university and an exemplary seat of learning and education at Nalanda. With proper guidance and support of the whole SXCE family, the tour turned out to be a mobile classroom. Students learned and enjoyed and returned to their places safely with fresh perspective.







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HUMAN RIGHTS

Father Manthra, before turning to the conceptual examination as to how could human rights be protected, addressed issues of percipience with evidence of prejudices, harassment and victimisation. He showed different videos for developing students' understanding of egalitarianism. The trainees in turn felt empowered to tackle prejudicial and harmful behaviours, thus becoming aware of the role teachers could play in developing equality and human rights culture in society.
